## Objective and Strategy

The Fund seeks to achieve a total rate of return which is comprised of capital appreciation and current income. The Fund uses the principles of value investing in order to identify companies across the entire economic spectrum.

## Investment Guidelines

- ☞ P/E below market
- ☞ Earnings growth equal to or above market
- ☞ Primarily, but not exclusively Large Cap stocks
- ☞ Typically, no more than 4% (at cost) in one stock
- ☞ Typically, no more than 15% (at cost) in one industry
- ☞ Turnover rate lower than industry averages

## About the Manager

Matrix Asset Advisors ("Matrix") has managed value-oriented equity portfolios since 1986, and currently manages approximately \$800 million in total assets. In July 1996, Matrix assumed the management of the Fund. Therefore, performance reflects Matrix management only since June 1996. The lead portfolio manager for both Matrix and the Fund is David A. Katz, CFA. Mr. Katz co-founded Matrix and has been its Chief Investment Officer since inception. The partners of Matrix, as well as their families and friends, are all owners of the Fund.

Earnings Growth = The annual rate of growth of earnings from business.

P/E Ratio = The Price/Earnings (P/E) ratio represents the median of an individual stock P/E. Individual P/E is calculated by dividing the current price by forward earnings. Price/Earnings for individual stocks are excluded when the figures are not meaningful, which includes negative earnings per share or depressed earnings per share.

Price/Book = The Price/Book (P/B) ratio represents the median of an individual stock P/B. Individual P/B is calculated by dividing the current price by current book value. Price/Book for individual stocks are excluded when the figures are not meaningful, which includes negative book value or statistically anomalous book value.
